I. REGISTRATION/FINANCES

A. Entrance Fees:

Rehoboth Beach PNP Registration Fee (Today-July 22nd, 2010)

- Registration fee: \$455 (7-Man)
- Registration fee: **\$250!!!** (5-Man)
- (includes all ref fees and 3 game guarantee)

NOTE: PNP must have a minimum of 12 teams (7 on 7) and 8 teams (5 on 5) to run a style of play. The 7 on 7 Screen football is the only style of play that will offer more than one division (A and B minimum). The maximum number of teams for this event is 32 teams for screen and 16 teams for contact flag. Team may register for both styles of play. NOTE: PNP is not responsible for scheduling conflicts. It is the team's responsibility to field the required number of players for scheduled games

- b Click onto the "Home" navigation link (top left)

- d **NOTE:** You will need to create a Pay Pal account if you are not already a paypal member you will need to register using a valid email address and select a password.

3) Credit/Debit Card Payment (Via www.paypal.com)-**CONTINUED**

- e Once you have selected “send money” you will need to enter:

- f Enter the amount of **\$455.00 US**; select “Purchase”, then select “Services”
- g The “Send Money” screen will re-appear and ask for your PayPal password; enter now
- h The “Review” page will come up next, allowing you to review your payment before finalizing
- i Click “Send Money”!
- j Click on “Transaction Details” for your receipt. Keep it and bring it. NOTE: The transaction is NOT FINAL until it has cleared the account. PENDING TRANSACTIONS will NOT be honored.

NOTE: Pay Pal Payments must be paid in full by July 22nd, 2010.

4) Individual Waiver Processing (**all participating players MUST appear on the roster and are responsible for completing an individual waiver**):

All individual waivers must be turned into the Pull N Pop registration table on 7/24/10, a minimum of one hour prior to the team’s first scheduled game.

II. SCHEDULES AND TOURNAMENT PLAY

A. Saturday Play for 7 on 7: Teams will be pre-seeded for Pool play based on (1) Team Entry Form Preference, (2) PNP '09 final standings and (3) current USFTL ranking points. Teams will play a minimum of two games on Saturday to determine seeding for the second day of play. Seeding will be based on the following formula: (1) Wins/Loss record, (2) Head to head finish (3) Cumulative margin of victory, (4) tiebreaker will be determined by strength of schedule, (5) a coin toss will be used if a fifth tiebreaker is needed between remaining teams to determine seeding.

B. Championship Sunday for 7 on 7: The top teams based on Saturday's record will be split into an upper and lower division for single elimination championship play. Note: Two division max.

C. 5 on 5 Play: Teams will be pre-seeded for Pool play based on (1) PNP '09 final standings and (2) current USFTL ranking points. The 5 on 5 style of play is double elimination.

D. Tie games for 7 on 7 and 5 on 5: Overtime Procedure for Tournament Games appears in the *PNP Rules and Style of Play* packet based on modified version of the National Federation of High School Association Football Rules Book and by the governing rules established by USFTL.

E. PNP reserves the right to move teams to a higher or lower division when necessary to maintain fair play and the competitive nature the PNP tournament.

F. Double Elimination Play may be used in the event more than 22 teams enter into the 7 on 7 style of play due to field limitations.

III. PROTESTS

A. Protests can be filed on a question of rule application only. An official's judgment cannot be protested.

B. Procedure: Only plays that occur *late* in the *fourth period of play and only have a direct bearing on the final outcome of the game can be protested.*

1. The contesting manager must make a formal protest with the coordinator, officials, and opposing team manager at the time of the infraction.
2. The game protest will be reviewed by tournament coordinator in which a decision will be rendered on the field. The game must resume within 5 minutes of protest. (Tournament Director must be contacted in all protest cases).
3. Complaints regarding the quality of officiating or violations of procedures committed by officials or coordinators shall be placed in writing to the coordinator for review.

IV. CONDUCT OF PLAYERS, COACHES, MANAGERS AND SIDELINE

A. No player, coach, or manager is advised to participate in any tournament game while under the influence of intoxicants. This rule is to be strictly enforced by each team captain upon entering team into the tournament play.

B. THE SALE, CONSUMPTION, OR POSSESSION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR OR BEVERAGES AND DANGEROUS OR NARCOTIC DRUGS OR GAMBLING OF ANY KIND IS PROHIBITED at any facility under the jurisdiction of Sussex County, Delaware and the Cape Henlopen School District.

C. All Board of Education and/or private agency property owners' rules governing the use of their facilities must be obeyed as part of these rules and regulations. Failure to adhere to this policy will cause any team to forfeiture their rights of utilize the approved facilities.

D. All teams are to be held responsible for any actions by any player, coach, spectator, etc, toward an official. Each team must control and/or identify anyone so involved or the team may and will be disqualified.

E. The captain of each team is responsible for unruly players and spectators affiliated with his or her team.

F. PNP reserves the right to disqualify any player, team or team affiliate at any time and for any reasons that are deemed detrimental to the over all governance of the PNP Tournament.

V. ASSUMPTION OF RISK/INSURANCE

- A. PNP carries a minimum of General Liability Insurance with an in addition to any optional coverage PNP elects to carry.
- B. All players, officials and event staff must return an Individual Liability Waiver and Assumption of Risk form and appear on team roster prior to participating in the PNP event. Failure to do so will result in the illegal player waiving all legal rights to sue Pull N Pop and all additionally insured. This will also result in the forfeiture of all team games that the illegal player has participated on.
